

\$1 per week (\$52 annually) provides:

- a **home visit** from a nurse for a family who has a child with special needs
- a **scholarship** for a week of before or after school care for a child whose family is in financial need
- **over-the-counter medications** not covered by food stamp benefits for 5 families
- **fall risk screenings and education** for 7 seniors to reduce the risk of potential injury
- one week of **emergency food** for a family of 4

\$5 per week (\$260 annually) provides:

- **breakfast & lunch** once a week for a year for 1 low income senior
- annual **physicals & immunizations** for 2 adults and 2 children
- **teeth cleanings** for 10 patients, preventing tooth decay and possible tooth loss
- two-hour **financial coaching appointments** for 5 families
- **back-to-school clothes, shoes, supplies and a backpack** for 2 children who would otherwise not have what they need to be ready to learn
