Common Questions



Who would I be driving?

Patients with minimal resources who do not have access to safe and reliable transportation, but still need to get to important medical visits within Chester County.

Do I have to drive all the time?

No! Once you are oriented and set up to select rides on the online system, you choose how often you want to volunteer.

All your hours will be tracked and we are available to answer questions or address concerns!

Will I be entering homes?

No. Pickup is curbside only.

Will I be driving people who can make me sick?

No.

Clients are attending prevention visits and are prescreened by CVIM for infection risk.



Do I have to be skilled on the computer?

No!

The online system is easy to use and staff will provide training and answer any questions you have.

Will I be transporting medical equipment like wheelchairs or oxygen tanks?

Will I be driving dangerous individuals?

Absolutely not. Neither VAR nor our partners would put volunteer drivers in any position that compromises their safety.

All clients are prescreened and approved by clinic staff before their participation.
