Since 2019, the United Way Mobile Home Tax Reassessment Program has collectively saved the participating mobile home owners \$9 million over the next 10 years that they should have never owed to begin with if not for a flaw in state tax code.

United Way of Chester County has partnered with Legal Aid of Southeastern Pennsylvania to continue this important work and scale it to assist all mobile home owners in Chester County.


